#### What is our Family Support Service?

The RSBC's free Family Support Service works with the families of children who have been diagnosed to help them understand the condition and build confidence for life.

We support vision impaired children and young people (age 0-25) and their family at home. From the moment a family hears the news, we can be on hand with practical and emotional support to guide them through their journey.

#### What will your Family Support Worker do?

Our Family Support Workers will work with your family on an individual basis, offering as much or as little support as required.

You'll receive the support you need to make decisions about your child's future, their education and help you take the lead in developing your child's independence and life skills.
